Before your flag is beyond repair, use the flag care guidelines on the reverse to keep your flag looking its best.

## FLAG CARE GUIDELINES

Our flags are manufactured using the highest quality U.S. made materials available. For best results, inspect your flag regularly and follow these guidelines when caring for your flag:

- CLEANING: Gently wash your flag in cool water with mild detergent and air dry thoroughly. Dry cleaning is recommended for cotton and polyester fabrics. If wrinkled, iron using the appropriate heat setting for the fabric.
- **REPAIR:** If the fly end of the flag begins to fray or tear, trim off and re-hem. This will extend the life of your flag.
- PLACEMENT: Your flag should be placed in an area with adequate room for it to fly freely and unobstructed. Keep the surface of your flagpole clean to avoid any soil transfer to the flag. Before severe weather – wind, rain or snow – take down your flag. If you are folding or storing your flag, be sure the flag is thoroughly dry.
- U.S. FLAG DISPOSAL: When a U.S. flag is in such a condition through wear or damage that it is no longer a fitting emblem or symbol, it should be destroyed privately in a dignified manner.
